We have an annual Fee of \$30 for Genealogy research. This enables you to come in and sit at the computer, write down as much information as you wish over a period of 1 hour. It also entitles you to come in again any time over the following 12 months with a charge of only \$5 each time and again you can write down as much information as you wish. If you require printouts these are \$10.50/ea, but if purchasing 5–9 we discount to \$9/ea, 10–19 are \$8/ea and 20 or more are \$7/ea. Certificates: Range from \$10.50 to \$30.00.
